



## 2018 TEAM SIZES AND PARTICIPATION RULES FOR BOX PROVINCIALS

### TEAM SIZES

- **Novice:** if a club has 20 or less players in this age group they will be allowed to have only one roster at no time shall they have more than 15 players on any roster for any game, all players must be played, and no player can be sat out more than once until everyone has sat out at least once. If there is an injury the SLA Convenor can give an exception for allowing a player to sit out more than once.
- **Pewee:** if a club has 20 or less players in this age group they will be allowed to have only one roster at no time shall they have more than 14 players (runners) on any roster for any game and up to 2 goalies. , all players must be played and no player can be sat out more than once until everyone has sat out at least once. If there is an injury the SLA Convenor can give an exception for allowing a player to sit out more than once.
- **Bantam:** if a club has 20 or less players in this age group they will be allowed to have only one roster at no time shall they have more than 14 players (runners) on any roster for any game and up to 2 goalies, all players must be played, and no player can be sat out more than once until everyone has sat out at least once. If there is an injury the SLA Convenor can give an exception for allowing a player to sit out more than once.
- **Midget:** if a club has 26 or less players in this age group they will be allowed to have only one roster at no time shall they have more than 18 players (runners) on any roster for any game and up to 2 goalies, all players must be played and no player can be sat out more than once until everyone has sat out at least once. If there is an injury the SLA Convenor can give an exception for allowing a player to sit out more than once.
- **GOALIES MUST BE DRESSED AS GOALIES.**

### CHANGING OF PARTICIPATION IN PROVINCIALS

1. No MA shall have a second team in provincials until each MA has the opportunity to register a team
2. If there is less than 8 teams the largest MA will be allowed to place a second team in the event. Then the second largest would go next and so on till the event is filled
3. If there is more than 8 MA's that have a team in a specific age group we will allow the event to grow to accommodate the increase of teams no MA will be left out of provincials
4. All teams except Saskatoon and Regina shall be allowed to top up their rosters to or create a all-star team:
  - Novice 14 players and 2 goalies
  - Pee wee 14 players and 2 goalies
  - Bantam 14 players and 2 goalies
  - Midget 18 players and 2 goalies

5. Saskatoon and Regina teams shall be allowed to pick up:
  - Novice 3 players and 1 goalie to a maximum roster of 14 players (runners) & 2 Goalies
  - Pee wee 3 players and 1 goalie to a maximum roster of 14 players (runners) & 2 Goalies
  - Bantam 3 players and 1 goalie to a maximum roster of 14 players (runners) & 2 Goalies
  - Midget 5 players and 1 goalie to a maximum roster of 18 players (runners) & 2 Goalies
6. All roster must be approved by the SLA and submitted to the SLA office by the appropriate deadlines.
